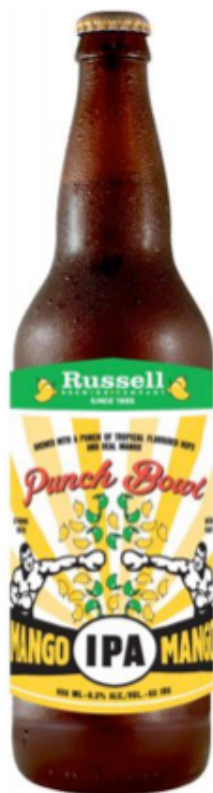

Style: Marzen Lager

Beau's Marzen (March or March Beer) is brewed with a special recipe allowing it to keep its freshness. Back in the day, brewing was forbidden in Germany from the end of April till the end of September. This gave the locals something to enjoy through the summer months until Oktoberfest. Beau's has brewed a beer inspired by this tradition and made it true to its style. It's an elegant and crisp beer with a light honeyed sweetness.

Nogne O Asian Pale Ale
Norway
Style: Spiced Pale Ale
500 ml

'Nogne O' is Norway's leading and most important supplier of Craft Beer. The name means 'naked island', a symbolic picture of what two Norwegian home brewers did in early 2002 by founding a new brewery. Their urge to share their passion of fantastic beer was unbearable. This beer is incredibly light yet thirst quenching. It has a generous amount of lemongrass added late in the brewing process for a little extra tang.

Russell Punch Bowl Mango
British Columbia
Style: India Pale Ale
650 ml

This is part of their limited seasonal series only available once a year. India Pale Ale was a beer that was created to survive the trip from England to India. Punch was a fruit drink introduced to England in exchange. So Russell designed a beer in tribute to full flavoured beer and to party drinks that can be spiked. Fresh mangos were added, along with mango nectar, to level out the bitterness and add some juiciness.

Steel & Oak Satsuma
British Columbia
Style: Hopped Lager
650 ml

Steel & Oak has always embodied the modernisms of today while remaining dedicated to the craftsmanship of years long past. Making its annual appearance, just in time for Oktoberfest, is their 'Satsuma'. A German-style Helles Lager that is dry hopped with Mandarina Bavaria hops giving it some refreshing tropical fruits on a clean, crisp finish. A lager with character!

Maisel's Weisse
Germany
Style: Dunkelweizen
500 ml

This is an old-fashioned wheat with some fine roasted malt. The aroma is like a typical hefe with some backbone. It carries lots of orange zest with prickly spice and a hint of green apple. The flavour is a mash of plums, apricot, cinnamon and lightly roasted malt for a smooth, creamy and refreshing aftertaste. It's a pretty classic 'dunkel' that is beautifully balanced. Definitely one of the top wheat beers!
