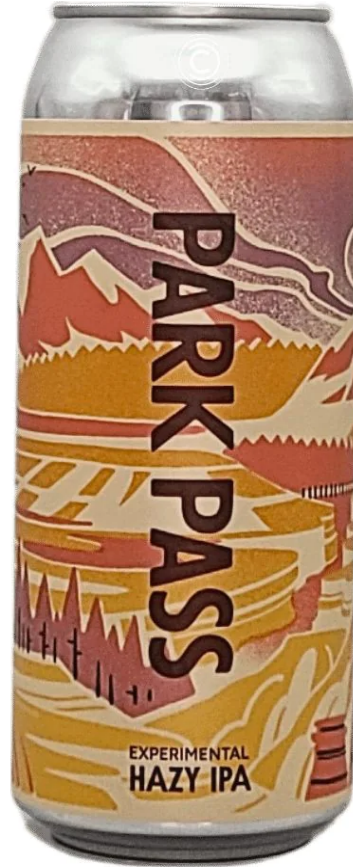

Steel & Oak Brewing has released a special collaboration with Superflux Brewing, called Boomerang 4. This is the fourth version of Boomerang, that's not brewed very often. The hop bill includes a blend of Vic Secret, Eclipse, Riwaka and Citra. It's a juicy monster of an IPA, sitting at only 7.7% abv. You'll taste a harmonistic blend of pineapple, mango, citron, clementine and orange marmalade with a touch of pine.

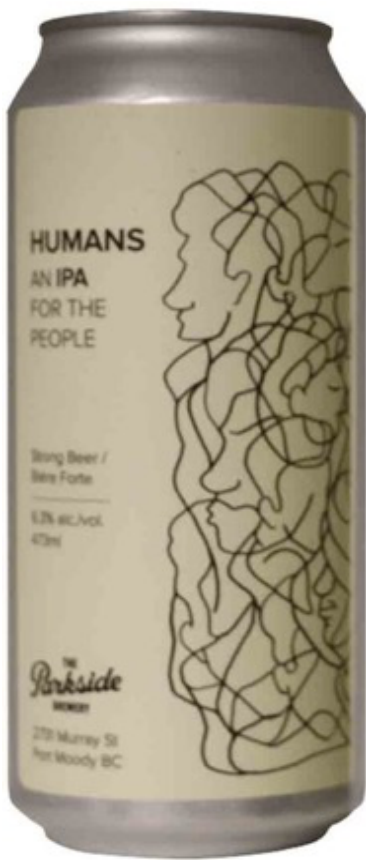


Small Gods 'Promised Land'

Small Gods is a family-owned-and-operated brewery, designed to fit into the community of Sidney by the Sea. Sidney is a tiny seaside village, beside the Swartz Bay ferry, that connects South Vancouver Island to the mainland. 'Promised Land' is a hazy pale ale, that's both easy drinking and very refreshing. It bursts a mix of citrus, orange zest, grapefruit and fresh guava with hint of caramel malt.

Inspired by the spirit of the Calgary '88 Olympics, Eighty-Eight Brewing opened their doors to the public in August 2018. Located in Inglewood, they've added some well-needed excitement of big flavours to the area. 'Streets Of Fire' is an explosive IPA, that is part of their small batch series. It's soft and cloudy, offering succulent notes of mango, freshly squeezed orange juice, fuzzy peach and nectarine.
