Rhone Valley, France

This creamy and crisp white is made from a blend of Grenache Blanc, Picpoul and Clairette. It offers notes of lemon balm, peach, apricot and lemongrass.

Tramier Pinot Noir

Burgundy, France

Stemming from the infamous region of Burgundy, is a savoury and expressive Pinot Noir. It offers a mix of blue and purple fruit with a hint of cured salami.

El Castro de Valtuille Mencia

Bierzo, Spain

Bierzo is a wine region in the northwest corner of Castilla y Leon, specializing in a grape varietal known as Mencia. It's like a basket full of berries with licorice.

Evel Douro Tinto

Douro, Portugal

Launched in 1913, this charismatic and foxy red is a blend of Touriga Franca, Touriga Nacional and Tinta Roriz. It's wonderfully elegant with a burst of fruit.

Clos Bellane Cotes du Rhone

Rhone Valley, France

This is a luscious and classic blend of Syrah and Grenache. It carries a mix of raspberry jam, blueberries, purple plum, and spicy herbs with silky tannins.
