'88 Cosmic Eye
Alberta
Style: West Coast IPA

Inspired by the spirit of the Calgary '88 Olympics, Eighty-Eight Brewing opened their doors to the public in August 2018. Located in Inglewood, they've added some well-needed excitement of big flavours to the area. 'Cosmic Eye' is a classic West Coast IPA, brewed for the Calgary Underground Film Festival. It's tart and tangy, offering notes of grapefruit, tangerine and kiwi, from the punchy combo of Citra and Amarillo hops.

Boombox Phantasm
British Columbia
Style: Hazy Pale

Boombox is a tiny project, brewed with the aid of Slow Hand Brewing, out of Vancouver. The owners of the Boombox label don't have their own facility but rather rent time and space from Slow Hand, to brew their own magic. This Hazy Pale is brewed with the addition of 'Phantasm'. This is a rich powder derived from New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc grapes, known for creating aromas of grapefruit and mango.

Four Winds Ultralite

Style: India Pale Ale

Situated just off the banks of the Fraser River in Delta, is a small brewery owned by the Mills Family. They opened their doors in 2013 and certainly play an important role in the BC Craft World. 'Ultralite' IPA is all in the name, which is a super light beer, coming in at only 2.9% abv. Think of it as a mini break from all the goodness out there but still showcasing some wonderful flavour and a bright bitterness.

The Establishment High Visceral

The Establishment is a brewery and taproom located in Calgary's growing Barley Belt brewing district. Mike Clark and Luke Pestl spent several years brewing in the Toronto beer industry, before branching out to open a small brewery and pub in downtown Toronto. 'Bootlegger' is a big West Coast IPA and a collab with Smugglers Trail Caskworks, out of BC. The hop blend includes a fusion of Vic Secret, Chinook and Simcoe hops. It bursts loads of tropical fruit, with a creamy malt base and a hint of piney resin and citrus.
